

2010 Etchells New England Championship - MBBC Fall Invitational

Malletts Bay Boat Club — Colchester, VT— September 17-19 2010

The organization authority is Etchells Fleet 25 and the Malletts Bay Boat Club.

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions of US SAILING, Etchells Class Rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any amendments thereto.

Entry Fee is \$105 (\$100 for US Sailing Members)

Entry fee includes coffee/bagels Saturday and Sunday AM, VT Micro "drinks" and a Casual Gourmet Dinner for your crew Saturday night. Awards for the top three boats.

All yachts must be in the water by 1000 Saturday September 18 and remain in the water for the duration of the regatta except by written permission from the Principal Race Officer (PRO). Storage of trailers will be off site. Launch and haul out using our 3 ton hoist.

Races will be sailed in Malletts Bay on Lake Champlain. The sailing instructions will be available during registration beginning on Saturday September 18, 2010. The courses to be sailed will be provided in the sailing instructions. As many races will be sailed as time allows. One throw-out after six races have been completed. Three races constitute a championship. All races will be scored accordance with low point scoring.

Registration is online and must be completed by September 15. Payment will be by PayPal/Credit Card or check during registration check-in.
